

## **DUNKLIN COUNTY TRANSIT SUSPENSION APPEALS POLICY**

Passengers of Dunklin County Transit can have their transportation services suspended due to a variety of reasons at the discretion of the Executive Director. Some of the reasons may include, but are not limited to: repeat offenders of no show, violation of passenger behavior policy, any violent/abusive behavior, etc. Any appeal must be submitted in writing to the Executive Director. Upon review of the appeal, the Executive Director in consultation with the Advisory Board will make the final suspension decision within seven (7) days of receiving the appeal. After the suspension decision is made, the Executive Director will have to issue the final suspension decision in writing within three (3) days to the passenger involved.

This policy was approved by the Dunklin County Transit Advisory Board on February 24, 2015.
